Outro, (Play the chords for two meassures)

After the last verse play the chorus-chords once, and then play these chords three times

Play it with lots of gain and trebble to get the waving sound. The strumming pattern

all the chords throughout the song is something like this:

Play the tones slowly and hold them for a long time with lots of vibrato, play the last tones a lot of times.

If the rhytm guitar plays the last chord(5577xx) you slide from the last tone(9) to the

6th fret, and hold it on for a time, like this:

```

```

For the rest of the song, the lead guitar plays, with lots of feedback, the chords, but only the tones from the D and G snare, so for the A-chord he plays for example:

```
G|-----6-----|
D|-----7-----|
```

But he does this with some effects and he varries a lot. It s hard to hear and to much work.
