I hope that the chord fingerings below make sense. I don t know the real names of the chords that I ve called such things as CaddG, but it s a C major with the high G note added on the first string and so on. Sorry about the capo placement, but my cassette player plays everything fast (about a half-step fast) so where I have to put my capo to play along isn t necessarily reliable. Just pick out the bass notes and see where it should go.

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YOU WILL BE WAITING  
(Capo on 2nd or 3rd fret; I can t remember which)

The numbers below denote the fret where the string should be held, not the finger that should be used. All fingerings are with the capo on.

**C** **G** (hold on the G chord)

There I'll always go

**F** **G**

Always go back whether or not you're waiting

CaddG **C/BaddG** **Am7** **Am7/G**

Ooh well I don't care if you'll be waiting

**Fm** **G** CaddG **C/BaddG**

Please say that you will be waiting there for me

**Am7** **Am7/G** **Fm** **C**
