Notes:

C/B: X2X01X

(this may not be its name, but this chord is used wherever you see it)

Play all G chords as 3x0033. You get a better sound for this particular song.

Throughout the piece, all E7s often change to E chords, and back again, and back again. Just take your ring finger off from the E chord and put it back in rhythmically.
