Am(2,7) - **D2**
D/F# - **G**
(play 4 times)

on the Am, hammer on the C (fret 1 B string) and the A (fret 2 G string), then hammer off the C (fret 1 B string) and switch to the D2. also the strum changes slightly on the fourth time, so listen to it.

C2(hammered/moving bass) - **G**
(play 16 times)

on the C2, hammer from B to C for the bass (fret 2 to 3 on A string), then keep going down in rhythm on the A string from fret 3 to 2 to 0 (open A string), then you switch to the G chord and hit it twice in the strum. again, listen to it ...
