Intro: **Eb D#dim7/ Bb G G7(#9)/F#9 F9/Bb6/**
(slashes separate measures in 4/4)

Bb6 **C13**
Your mind is made up you won t even try
Eb **Bb**
You didn t even cry this time
Bb6 **C13**
You say that we can never see eye to eye
Eb **Bb**
And one of us just must be blind
Eb **D7**
We have our differences, we re still the same
Gm **C7**
