Even if it's not 100% accurate or to your liking, if you play around with these cords you will get pretty damn close. There are only 4 basic cords, much like many of Daughter's other songs...

Capo 5: the chorus is C - G - Am - F, although variation happens throughout depending on how you want it to sound.
