(Jemaine):

F

G

(Bret):

G7

E7

F

G7

F

It s quite a lot, actually.

G

(Bret):

C

Ooh, I love you,

(Jemaine):

I love you, you, you, you,

(Bret):

E

(Jemaine):

F

I need you, you, you, you, you, you, you, you.

G

(Jemaine):

G7

Ditto that.

(Bret):

E7

(Jemaine):

F
