The song is played in an open G tuning (DGDGBD) with capo on fret 2.

Strumming pattern is essentially creating a steady rhythm on the bass G string with your thumb while strumming the rest however it feels comfortable for you.. but basically play it however you want with a carefree strumming hand to get a good groove on.

Here are the chords used, not sure of their proper names but i've just named them for easy reading:
