- A -A sort of arpeggio but strummed downwards once with the thumb.
- \* -The lower string is plucked very slightly earlier than the top one. Almost like a grace note.
- () -An implied note. Sometimes it is a string that is struck lightly by mistake, in other instances, it is the rest of the chord.
