I believe the electric guitar in the song is playing some of the chords higher, (especially the F# and C#), so transpose to your liking. As you can see above, most of the song is played near the middle of the guitar, so try to avoid playing low transpositions like A#m = [x13321]. Here are some other suggestions that sound right, but could get painful if you're trying with an acoustic:
