Please this song using barre chords only. The first measure of a chord is played with the full barre chord structure. The second is played by lifting finger one (the pointer finger) only, but keeping the other finger(s) in place. It gives this song its rollicking sing-a-long feel.

Intro: D (use the fifth fret double barre chord and alternate full chord with lifting finger one. This rhythm repeats the whole song)
