
Lots of techno stuff, not so sure what is guitar and what isn t, but heres tab for it.

In much of the rythm of this song, about 3 or more intruments play the same part with differnt sounds. The bass plays the same thing as the rythm (So I would assume). So, if you needed a bass tab, just play the bottom nots (tab wise) of the rythm parts on your base. Remember, the bottom for strings of a guitar are the same as a bass, just an octave lower. Anyway, here s the music.
