Dm7/G	3 x 0 2 1 1

Note the reversal of C and F on the third line of verses 1 & 2.
Lead into verse 2 with Gsus4 G as shown in (), omit on second and third chorus.

Intro:

C / Em / Am7 / F / C / F / C / Gsus4 G

Verse 1:

C **Em**
He tells her, I want to paint you naked on a big brass bed
Am7 **F**
with bright orange poppies all around your head.
C **F** **C** **F**
And she says, Crazy old man, I m not young anymore.
Dm7 **G7sus4** **G7**
That s all right, he whispers, I ve never painted before.

Chorus:

C **F** **C**
Do you love me Lady Jane, Lady Jane?
C **F** **Gsus4** **G**
Do you love me Lady Jane, Lady Jane?
C **Em** **Am7** **F**
You got me talkin to the moon, you got me walkin in the rain.
C **F** **C** (**Gsus4** **G**)
Do you love me, do you love me Lady Jane?

Verse 2:

C **Em**
I want to read your tea leaves by candle light.
Am7 **F**
On a fat velvet sofa, I want to be with you all night.
C **F** **F** **C**
I want to tickle your feet with a peacock plume.
Dm7
And she says, Can you talk a little softer,
G7sus4 **G7**
there are people in the room.

(Chorus)

Bridge:

Bb6
And Jane says, my children brought me here
A7
and promised me they'd call.
Dm7 **G7sus4** **G7**
Well you know kids forget that's just the way of it all.
C **Em** **Am7** **F**
And he says, Well, that makes us both footloose and fancy free,
Dm7 **Dm7/G**
so Jane do you want to come see the Painted Desert with me?
