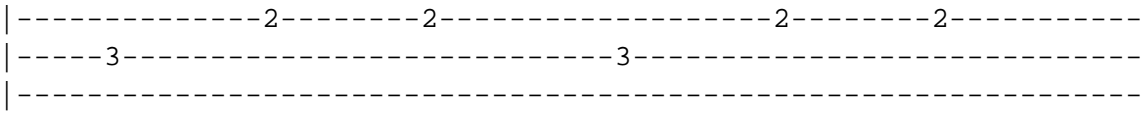
I made a lot of my own mistakes
