So in G/F# just press with your index finger the 6th string in 2nd fret,  
and mute the 5th string  
For the Dsus-D, just do a regular D [--0232] and press the 1st string with your pinky  
in 3rd fret, then lift it up for a standard D

This is the way I play it, but maybe Jason plays it without capo

1/2 step down (he usually does), you can try it, just change the chords:

EADGBE

**G = A** [-02220]

**G/F# = Amaj7** [-02120]

**Am = Bm** [-24432]

**Dsus = Esus** [022200]

**D = E** [022100]

**Em = F#m** [244222]

**Bm = C#m** [-46654]

**C = D** [--0232]
