This song is all basic chords except the intro.
You can play open chords with a capo on 3, but Los Lonelys play it without a capo and use all barre chords.

This is the non-capo version. A brief capo 3 version is at the bottom.

Intro:

Cm (8th fret) **Bb** (6th fret) **Cm** **Bb**

You can tell by listening to the intro that he does hammer-ons and pull-offs during the intro. It s very easy to do. For the Cm, do it by moving your pinky from the 4th string down to the 1st string onto fret 10. For the Bb hammer-on, move your pinky from the 4th string to the third string on the 8th fret.

It s very easy, and the rest of the song is chords.

Verse:

Bb (6th fret) **Bb**
I m calling up my Cherie, to tell her that I m gonna leave

Eb (6th fret) **Ebm** **Bb**
Cause I m moving on to Hollywood you see (repeat)

1st Chorus:

Cm (8th fret) **F** (8th fret)
And I know I can t go wrong

Cm **F**
Cause I finally found my song

Cm **F**
And I m headed where I belong

Next Choruses:

Cm **F**

Solo (**Cm Bb Cm Bb**)

Bridge: (all barre chords)

D Gm C (3rd fret) **Cm**
F (8th fret) **Eb Dm Cm Bb**

Back to verse then chorus

End with Cm and Bb

Capo Version: Capo on 3rd fret (this makes the bridge a lot easier)

Intro: **Am G**

Verse: **G G C Cm**

1st Chorus: **Am D Am D Am D G**

Other Choruses: **Am D Am D Am D Am Am G**

Bridge: **B Em A Am**
