This is Luka Bloom's version of Dancing Queen. If you listen to the record, he does this in Drop D tuning, but I decided to just go with standard tuning as it can be a pain to tune in the middle of a gig.

Intro: **C - F - C - F**

G **E**
You can dance, you can jive
Am **Am/G** **D/F#**
Having the time of your life.
F **Dm**
Oh, see that girl, watch that scene,
G **C** **F - C - F**
Diggin' the dancing queen.

Verse 1:

C **F**
Friday night and the lights are low.
C **Am**
Looking out for a place to go.
G **Am**
Where they play the right music
G **Am**
Getting in the swing.
Em **Am** **Em - Am**
You've come to look for a king.

C **F**
Anybody could be that guy.
C **Am**
Night is young and the music's high.
F **Dm**
With a bit of rock music
F **Dm**
Everything is fine,
Em **Am** **Em - Am**
You're in the mood for a dance.
F **G**
And when you get the chance...

Chorus:

C F C F - G
 You are the dancing queen, young and sweet, only seventeen.
 C F C F
 Dancing queen, feel the beat from the tambourine.
 G E
 You can dance, you can jive
 Am Am/G D/F#
 Having the time of your life.
 F Dm
 Oh, see that girl, watch that scene,
 G C F - C - F
 Diggin the dancing queen.

Verse 2:

C F
 You re a tease, you turn em on.
 C Am
 Leave em burning and then you re gone
 G Am G Am
 Looking out for another, anyone will do,
 Em Am Em - Am
 You re in the mood for a dance.
 F G
 And when you get the chance
