Standard tuning. Capo 1st fret.

Chords used: Relative to capo.

G - 32033
Em7 - 022033
Cadd9 - X32033
G/F# - 200033
D - XX0232
Bm - X24432

You can use an Em (022000) instead of the Em7 and a C (X32010) in place of the Cadd9,
just see which you think sounds better.

The piano comes in after the second run through playing the chords G - Em7 - Cadd9

Verse:

G **G/F#**
Tonight I cried the tears of a child

Em7 **D**
Who knows what fears run deep and wild inside

Cadd9 **G** **Em7** **Cadd9**
But the river s in flood tonight

G **G/F#**
I layed down and the light streamed across my face

Em7 **D**
I felt the beauty of some deeper grace and I tried

To find my way to the other side

Chorus:

Now I, feel you skin as smooth as silk

Drunk like a baby on his mama s milk

Take me down under the wishing tree

And lay your healing hands on me

and then back to the verse again, repeat it and the chorus

The bridge bit uses the chords:

Bm - Cadd9 - Em7 - D

Then the solo: over the chords G - D - Em7 - D - Cadd9 - G - Em7 - Cadd9
