The chords aren't full, though, so here's what I've come up with:

Em = 000220 (normal)

C = 010230 (normal)

G = 030023 / 000023

D = 032002 / 002002 / 030450

As for the variations for G and D, you can just decide which one goes best for which part. But he is always playing the top E string open, so keep that in mind

(all the chords listed have the E open).

Em **C**

G
Tell me what is your color
