I play it in the Key of G (Capo 4). It can be played open in the Key of B with these Chords: **B, F#/A#, G#m, E, F#, E/G#**

note: I think it also sounds good, maybe even better, substituting Em7 [0 2 2 0 3 3] for Em, Cadd9 [x 3 2 0 3 3] for C, and Dsus4 [x x 0 2 3 3] for D.

Strum pattern for beginners - First, listen to the song. The fast part (end of verse lines, end of chorus) I play:

G **D/F#** **Em** **C**
 D D UUUDUDU D D UUUDUDU

During the verse just play and let ring out the initial single chord until the jam above.

During the chorus, I play something like this (hitting just the root note sometimes on down strums including the initial strum):

D D DU D D D DU D D D DU D D D DU D D D DU

G **C** **D** **G**
Praise is waiting for You in this place
