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Structure:

Intro - Verse1 - Chorus - Intro
- Verse2 - Chorus - Chorus bis - Solo - Outro

Intro/Verses/Outro:

[A Amaj7] [A7 A7sus4 *] [Bm A] [E E7sus4 *] (x2)

[Chorus]

Bm E Bm E
Bm E C#m F#m
[Bm A] E

Chorus bis + Solo:

[Bm A] E [A A E] F#m (x4)
[Bm A] E

For the intro and verse, you can go with a finger picking for these chords:

[A Amaj7] [A7 A7sus4 *] [Bm A] [E E7sus4 *]

and trying to fit the melody where * is indicated.

I think there is no need for a real tab, the arpeggio is relatively simple.

Capo: Don't use a capo if you want to play like the original song. But I prefer having a capo on the 3rd fret (for example), it's easier for me to sing.
