The way I ve tabbed it is the easiest way I can think of to play this song. I believe that the actual recording has a capo on the first fret. Or, since every song on the entire tape seems to play a little bit above standard tuning, they may tune a little higher—I really don t know. The tab is shown for playing w/o the capo, if you use the capo, just pretend the first fret is zero. Play with or without a slide, whatever floats your boat (I can t play slide worth a damn.)

The capo should be good enough to play with the recording. To just jam without the recording leave everything open. BTW, I m not even going to try to transcribe any of the harmonica parts over to guitar. Enjoy...





Also in the background is occasional short appearences of part of a different G5 chord (xx00xx). Listen to the recording if you want to try to throw those in. Those eventually lead into the following:
