The song is in G (or Em). You can finish the song with a few notes on the Em pentatonic.

Hammer on the 2nd string with your 3rd finger during the Bm part.
Hammer on the 2nd string with your 2nd finger and then hammer on and pull off on the 1st string with you pinkie during the Am Part. (You should feel when to do so)

Intro (played with Triads)

G / G / G C / G C /

Verse (played with open chords except Bm as a Bar Chord)

G (3 beats) / **Em** (4 beats) (at 3 and a half beat play an F# (1st string 2nd Fret) before going to Em)
Baby Lou I look at you

Bm (3 beats) / **Am** (4 beats)
Things you say are often true

G (3 beats) / **Em** (4 beats)
You seemed embarrassed, was I too ?

Bm (3 beats) / **Am** (4 beats)
True romance is sometimes blue
