Standard tuning, no capo. All chords in the 1st position, except for the D/A at the first line of coda.

C/B and B/C in the tab are single note walkups and walkdowns.

Song requires a precise G to G6sus4 strumming Hammer Pull pattern; tried to get G6sus4 on the right syllable

of each line...watch and listen to see how he hits those G6sus4 syllables at the right moments. Note that this

G5sus4 fingering is also considered a C/G. If you don t mute the A string, the chord is Am7/G. Muted when

slowly strummed sounds better, but he s doing the hammer pull so quickly it doesn t matter that much.

The other requirement--get a fast run down from the four fingered C/G to Cmaj9/E to Amin7 to G in the

intrumental transition to get into the next verse.

Coda may or may not go from Amin to Amin7, in a brief pull off, but works with a straight Amin.

Coda may also have some straight Ds as well as the Dsus2, but works either way.
