\*\*\*Make sure you play the top strings on the Cadd --> Bm/G --> Em7/G\*, because of the progression, E, F#, and G (not the actual notes you re playing. You re actually playing A#, C, and C#)

I m not so sure about the Em7s, I think you can replace them with a G of some kind or Cadd9. You can also replace the Bm/G with a D. The Gsus2 can be replaced with a D (of some kind), Cadd9 or another G. Cadd9 can be replaced with C6/9. Ah, whatever! If something sounds wrong, post a correction and I ll look into it.

When in doubt, use the chord progression in Brielle. C G D Em7 C G D It s essentially the same. OH! And a big thanks to the dude (Jeremy Keltner) that did the tab for this song. It took a long time transposing and arranging chords from his tabs in such a way so that they don t sound like a dying cat, or your classmates singing happy birthday. \*shudders\* Again, have fun!
