Beyond the Wheel

Dropped D Tuning (D, A, D, G, B, e)

(Intro and verse part)

e-----|I
B-----|I
G-----|I
D--0----(5)---|I
A--0----(5)---|I
D--0----(5)---|I

NOTE: The numbers in parenthesis are NOT fretted. I think they re tapped harmonics. To get them to sound right, play the first three open strings and lightly tap those same strings across the fith fret. Play this a lot during the intro and verse.

(Chorus(?) part)

NOTE: The last time this is played, do not play the last two chords. Go right into the Post chorus.

(Post chorus)

NOTE: After playing the above three times, only play the first three chords for the fourth time. During the next verse, play the Chorus(?) part. For the verse after that, play the Chorus(?) part, but substitute the second set of chords with a bunch of pick scrapes. Then comes the solo.....Just play a D pentatonic, and strum behind the bridge if you can. As for the rhythm guitar, play the exact thing that was played under the last verse mentioned above. Finally, end the song with this:
