The Intro is a little confusing, if you want to get it right. The chords are basically...

You can play this and still sound good. But if you want to be perfect, then you should know that the guitarist also, after the Asus2, plays all open strings once, and an Em chord once, then repeats the whole thing. The second time he does this, he doesn't play the Em chord, and just goes right to E.

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(* the v^v is to show downstrokes and upstrokes, if you were to continually
move your
hand up and down,even when not playing a note. I use it as a timing
measurement.)
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Please note: I left an open E string in the bass for the whole time because it is actually there. it s not a typo. this is reflected in the chords below as well.
