I think on the original single version the guitars are tuned a half-step down from standard tuning (or maybe it was in concert pitch, but the backing tracks were slowed down before the vocals were added)

I m sure this is not the way the Kinks played it, but I think it works well when you only have one guitar to accompany yourself.

To try and emulate the Indian feel of the droning strings, slide the shape for the D6sus2/E up two frets for the E7sus2 chords.

The names sound very complicated, but a lot of the shapes I ve selected are relatively similar and simple moveable chords.
