Intro: **C-Am-C-Am**

**C** **Am**  
Love, I won't break your heart;  
**G** **Am** (**G**)  
It's a long way down from here.  
**C** **Am**  
Every time you fall and break apart,  
**G** **Am** (**G**)  
I will pick you up again.

**C** **G**  
With your head up high, would you try,  
**Am** **Em** **F**  
try to place your feet back on the ground.  
**G** **Am** **G**  
I've found that it's easier to hide  
**C** **G**  
in the cold alone;  
**Am** **Em** **F** **G**  
an arrival since the day you fell apart.  
**Am** **G**  
Oh but honey I'm alive.

Repeat **C-G-Am-Em-F-G-Am-G**

**C** **Am**  
Love, I won't break your heart,  
**G** **Am** (**G**)  
'cause I've seen this all before.  
**C** **Am**  
You're a fire that grows from just a spark,  
**G** **Am** (**G**)  
and then walks right out the door.

C G  
 With your head up high, would you try,  
 Am Em F  
 try to place your feet back on the ground.  
 G Am G  
 Iâ€™ve found that itâ€™s easier to hide  
 C G  
 in the cold alone;  
 Am Em F G  
 an arrival since the day you fell apart.  
 Am G  
 Oh but honey I m alive.

F G  
 Crying on the phone,  
 C Am  
 when you said you were alone.  
 F G  
 I am gonna stay,  
 C Am  
 though your friends have gone away.  
 F G  
 All the secrets that we have  
 C Am  
 only keep the worlds alive.  
 F G  
 But you ve got something left to give,  
 C Am  
 if you d only learn to live.

C G  
 With your head up high, would you try,  
 Am Em F  
 cause youâ€™re the only one to pull me through.  
 G  
 Its true,  
 Am G  
 and it seems a waste of time  
 C G  
 to grow old alone.  
 Am Em F G  
 Weâ€™ve been dying since the day we fell apart.  
 Am G  
 Oh but honey I m still alive. Iâ€™m still aliveâ€|

Repeat 2x C-G-Am-Em-F-G-Am-G

Ends on C

If you don't want to tune your guitar down, you can use a capo on the 2nd fret and replace C with A, Am with F#m, G with E, F with D, and Em with C#m, and that sounds okay too.
