Some odd ones:

D7Sus4 = x20200

Bmin6 = x20100 " With these two he moves quickly from the **E7sus4** to the **Bmin6**, and plays

the g string then the b string in each case.

Csus2/A = x20230

This song has a lot of "twiddly" bits on the high e and b strings, revolving around the

3rd and 5th fret I think. These are just the basic chords, but if you play around with

adding stuff on the bottom two strings then I think this is pretty close so far.
