I have played this along to the song to test it and it sounds good, and as a bonus is not too complicated.

INTRO:

This is followed by three drum beats, and then the song starts with 2 overlapping guitars and a bass line. It s hard to distinguish between them at times, but I m pretty sure this is how it goes.

VERSE:

The second chorus goes twice, and for its second time round,

Then there s a bit with a faster tempo that I can t figure out
so I just play the chords E and A alternately for a bit.

Finally, the solo goes like this:
