D **Em**

is the pressure you feel that you have to act

C **D**

That everything is clearer when youâ€™re looking at the past, oh no.

(**Em**, **C**, **G**, **D**) x 2

C

And I donâ€™t care if I lose,

G

because my heroes did too.

D

I shouted "Court should be adjourned,

Em (C)

because the jury are fools.

G

D

(C)

And the judge can't decipher his left from his right, or his right from his wrong.

D

(C)
