Now, on to the solo... I only did parts of it because there were a few parts which were too fast for my ears, and besides, no one wants to play the song exactly the way it is on the disc, so I did most of it, and skipped the really fast parts... I also forgot to put in bar lines, but most of it is separated by phrases, so you should have no trouble following along. So here we go:

Opening bend:

High E string, fretted at the 22nd fret. Push down on the bar so that the note that sounds is 2 1/2 steps lower (i.e. the 17th fret). After picking the note, slowly release the bar, and bend up a whole step. Eventually, bend this up another half step, to hit F. Then release. This takes some practice, but it is a pretty neat technique.
