For his run up riff on the E chord check out the tab for the intro to Banded Clovis. Otherwise, watch the video above to get a feel for the song. The Esus4 is just a hammer on and off from the E chord. Notice that he likes to hammer on the B on the A string while playing the open E chord. Notice also that when he plays the B7 he s switching between the B and the F# in the base.
