Standard Tuning - Capo 1

Chords - are hammered-on twice during the chord  
[ ] are pulled off to open the string for last strum of chord

(relative to capo)

The into and verse strum pattern are the same - there is a hammer on and off on the D string during the C chord twice to get that note change, and the G string is opened at the end of the F chord.

Listen to the song and mess around with hammering during the C chord and opening the F chord and you will get it!
