In the intro, the full chord actually seems to be played, which isn't really possible with a single guitar.

If you have two guitars, then you should play each bass note as follows:

[Guitar 2] - bass notes:

- First note of each chord is played when the first bass note of each chord is played with Guitar 1
- Need some visual reference? In the intro, the chord name aligns with the first bass note of each chord (C, G, Am, Em F, etc.)
- Numbers are more so intended as vocal cues
- Chord names are just cues for when the chord is started, and for guitar 2 to be able to play in tandem with guitar 1
- With two guitars, you could probably omit the bass note from guitar 1 (no need
